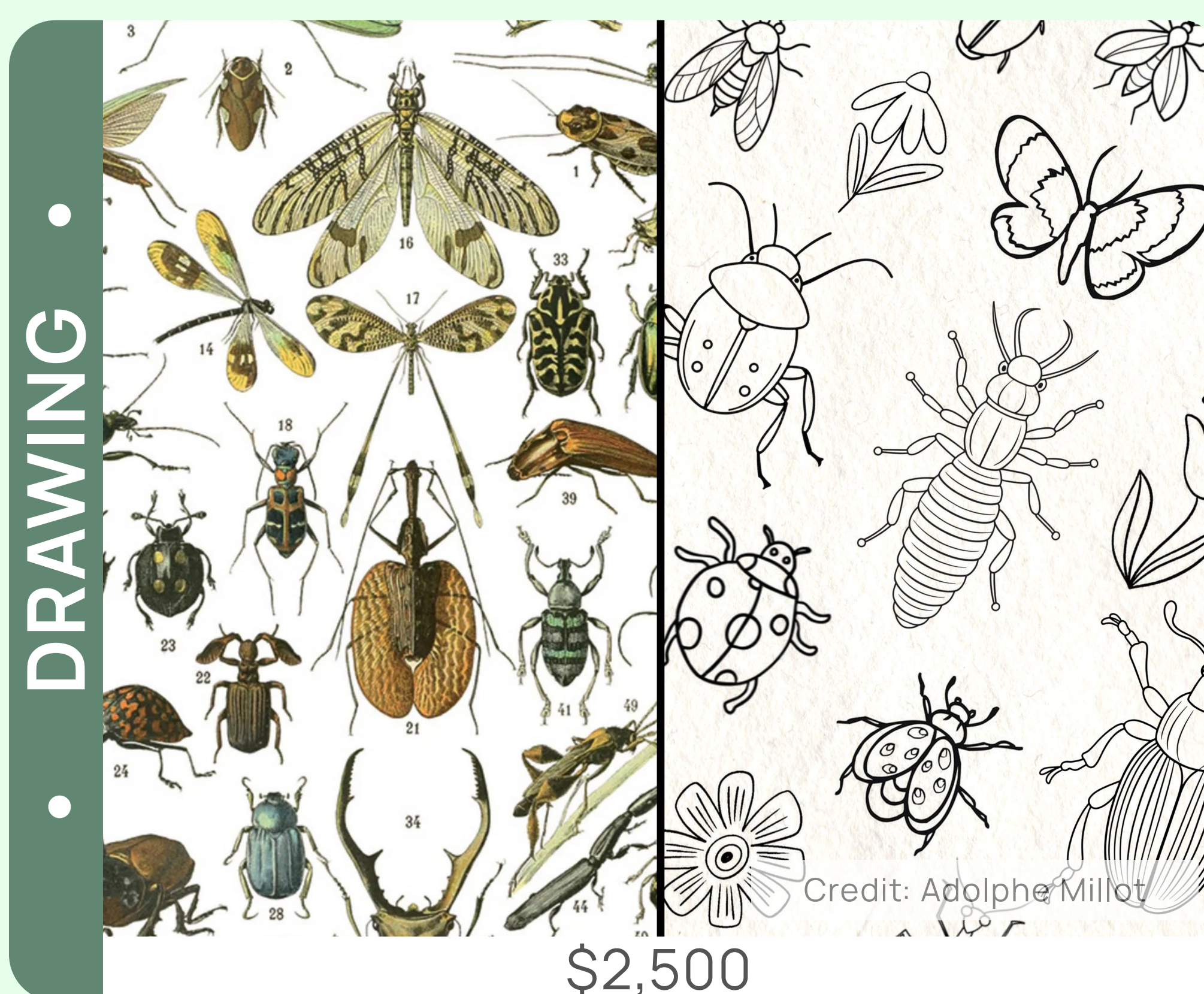

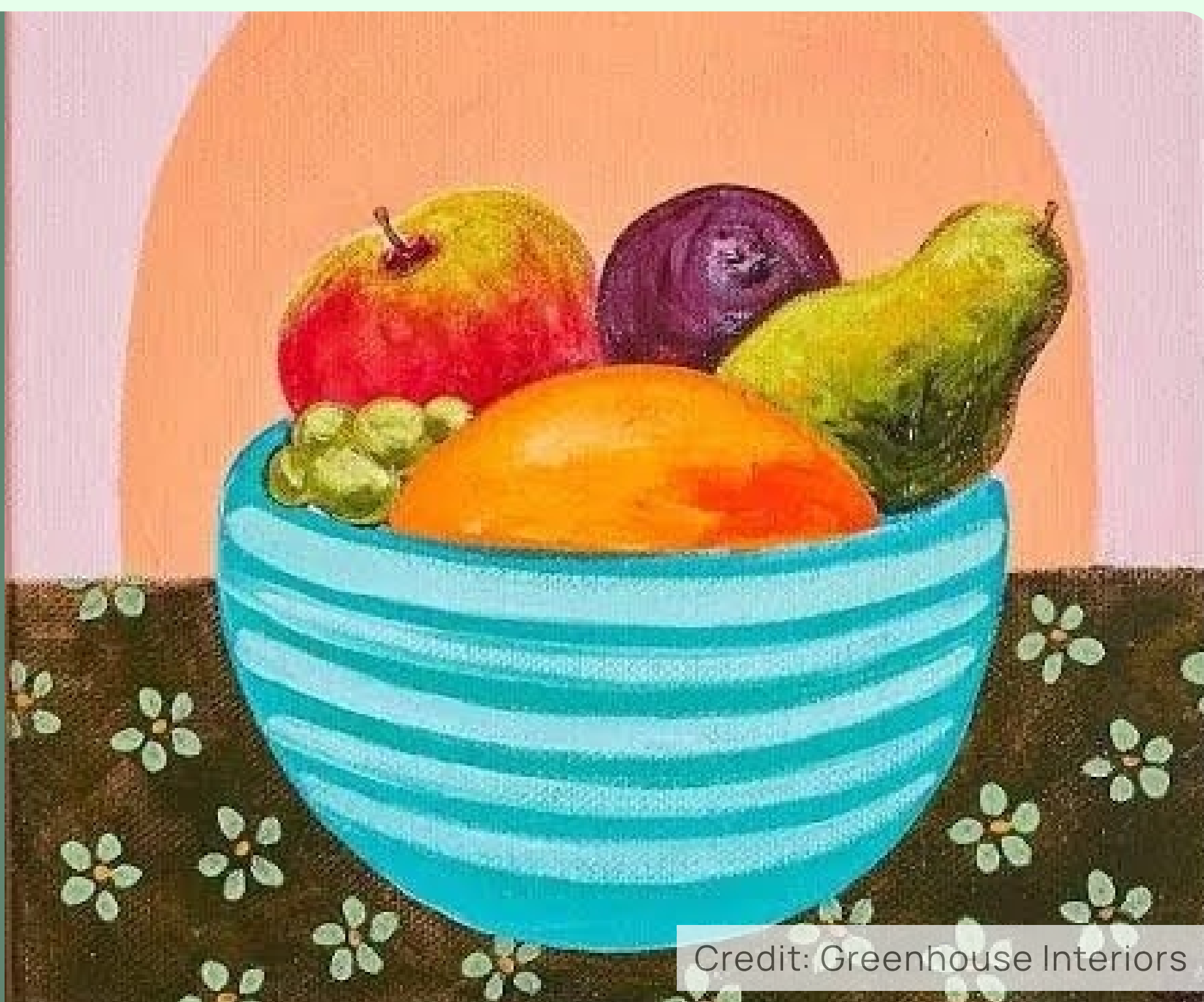

# FRUIT BOWL STILL LIFE

The act of 'looking' is the most important part of observational drawing. Understand 3D depth and spatial coherence on a 2D plane as you draw your still life with the aid of 2D stencils.
